

## Public Notice of Rights Under Title VI

## Information

**Reservations are required 1 day/24 hrs in advance of trip @ 608-647-4616**  
**Routes will not run if there are no reservations.**

**Cost:** \$3 one-way or \$5 round-trip  
Cost is per person.

**Who can ride:** Anyone!

**Trip Time:** Bus leaves Richland Center at 8:15 a.m. and leaves destination city no later than 2:00 p.m. to return.

**Destination City:** Passengers will be able to stop as many places as possible in the destination city at no additional cost. Number of stops depends on number of passengers.

**Catching the bus:** Richland County Public Transportation will go within five miles of a route and pick you up at home! Don't live within five miles of a route? Call to find ways to use the bus routes.

**Accommodations:** Anyone needing special accommodations can reach out to the program.

# Route Schedule

Reservations are required 1 day/24 hrs in advance; the bus routes do not run without reservations. Call 608-647-4616 for reservations.

Bus will pick passengers up at home and will go within five miles of the route.

A route will only go to the alternate destination city upon request otherwise all routes will return to Richland Center.
